



The Frank S. and Agnes V. Batavick **Family Scholarship Fund**

To commemorate St. Rose of Lima School's 100 Year Anniversary and to honor the memories of their parents, Frank and Agnes, the Batavick Family has established a \$100,000 Scholarship Fund. This Scholarship Fund will provide scholarships to students needing financial support to attend St. Rose of Lima School.

Frank and Agnes Batavick and family moved from Philadelphia to Audubon in 1947. As devout Catholics, they became members of St. Rose of Lima Parish. Their children; Agnes (1953), Peg (1956), Frank (1959) and George (1962) all graduated from St. Rose School.



Frank and Agnes led their faith-based lives stressing and demonstrating the importance of the Catholic faith, family, friends, and education. Both instilled strong work ethics in their children, along with the need to always respect and help others.

The Batavick Family has many fond memories of their over 70-year association with St. Rose Parish and School. These include the renowned pound cake Agnes baked for the Christmas Bazaar, the wooden manger Frank made for the church's Nativity Scene; attending Christmas midnight mass and the annual May procession. School activities included noon basketball officiated by the Monsignor, Boy and Girl Scouts, candy and flower sales for Easter. There were also fun class trips to Riverview Amusement Park and the Dominican Motherhouse in Newburgh, NY. Graduations were held in the auditorium with some graduating classes having over 100 students
