### "Merry Lent"

Lent is a time to refocus and clear our minds and hearts. As we travel through the forty days of lent let us look at it as an opportunity to be open to Jesus Christ in our lives. As we walk through Christmas you will hear people say "Merry Christmas" to be open to the joy and grace of the birth of Our Savior Jesus Christ. Jesus became the Incarnate Son of God into the world to make a change to make a difference in the soul of every human being.

I would ask you to have a "Merry Lent" to allow Jesus Christ to enter your mind and heart to make a difference in the world.

To be an ambassador of Christ to others. It is said that the only gospel that people sometimes see in the actions that we do. St. Francis said, "preach the gospel always and sometimes use words."

As we do during Christmas we decorate the Christmas trees with lights, ornaments and place wrap gifts under the tree for the celebration of the coming of Jesus Christ into the world. I would like us all to take that image and have a "Merry Lent." Not to use Lent and as a time of dome (some terrible fate) and gloom (appearing depressing or frightening) but to infuse and illumined the light of Christ into our inner lives. That the fruits of the Holy Spirit are empowering us and engaging us in love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, generosity, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control.



During lent we focus on **prayer**, fasting and almsgiving. Just as we decorate the Christmas Tree with lights, let **us use the light of prayer to illuminate us with the Holy Spirit**. May people see the glow and radiance of your spirituality in the actions and deeds that you do. May your prayer life engage your heart and mind to prepare you for a full relationship with Jesus Christ. The light of the Holy Spirit is given to us by the seven gifts of the Holy Spirit: wisdom, understanding, counsel, fortitude, knowledge, piety and fear of the Lord.

When you **fast** (to give up something for lent) make it something that you turn away from that is a reminder of the importance of putting Christ first in your life. Just like a **special ornament** that hangs on the Christmas Tree it brings us to a place in which we can contemplate that moves our inner being.

Fasting should be something that is not seen as punishment or chore. It should spark you to engage the Holy Spirit deeper into your life. Taking time away from your cell phone and sitting quietly in silence to think of our spiritual relationship.

Taking time to really practice actively listening to others and not just going through the motions. To physically engage your spirituality by taking a walk for 15 to 20 minutes instead of watching the television or sitting at your computer.

To give **alms** to others should be as we give Christmas presents that are meaningful and purposeful to the individual in need of that gift. As we take time to shop and wrap these special gifts, may we wrap our almsgiving with kindness, love and respect.

to others is a wonderful gift for a person in a time of need. To say please, thank you and I am sorry with compassion and respect.




#### **Note from the School Nurse**
