(This gap between tuition and cost to educate is even wider with second and third children as the tuition rates decrease with each sibling.)

National Junior Honor Society

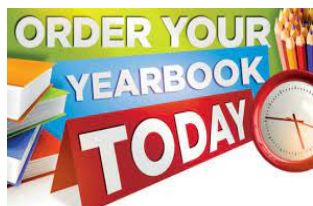
