Here we are again at Christmas Bazaar Week! There are a few items I want to go over this week as we prepare for the big day.Looking forward to all of the excitement that this week brings, while also continuing to maintain our important routines.

- 1. **Bazaar Day Uniforms: Winter Uniform with Christmas Accessories!** Students should wear their formal Winter uniforms on Bazaar day. They are permitted to wear festive Christmas accessories such as hats, necklaces, earrings etc. Anything that covers the students' face is not permitted.
- Half Day of School with <u>No Aftercare</u> on Friday, November 10 Due to the Christmas Bazaar, we will not be offering AfterCare on Friday, November 10.. Thank you for your understanding.
- 3. Afternoon Dismissal on Christmas Bazaar Day Friday, November 10 All students will be dismissed from the 3rd Ave doors on Bazaar day. Students in grades 6-8 will be dismissed by teachers in school and allowed to exit the building on their own. We will begin staging students outdoors for dismissal at 11:35 a.m. for Kindergarten and 11:45 a.m. for grades 1-8. If you are volunteering at the Bazaar during dismissal time and cannot step away from your booth, please make arrangements in advance for a family member or friend to pick up your student outside.

Santa will be coming to school on Friday morning to take group pictures with each homeroom on the decorated Bazaar stage! 
