

DRAMA DEPARTMENT RULES AND REGULATIONS:

- Absences from rehearsal must be reported via text to Mia Reich 609-238-9735 by 90 minutes prior to the rehearsal
- Unexcused absence from rehearsal (no-show/no-call) will result in being cut from the scene rehearsed that day
- Actors who miss rehearsals are expected to learn what they have missed using provided rehearsal videos.
- Cast members who were absent from school due to illness are not permitted to attend play practice that day
- Cast members should NOT come to rehearsal if they are less than 24 hours symptom-free from any contagious illness (fever, stomach virus, new cold/cough)
- TECHNICAL DRESS REHEARSALS ARE MANDATORY

We work hard to maintain a positive and nurturing environment in the drama program, and ask that cast members and their parents do so as well:

- Cast members must be respectful and mindful of the adults who are responsible for them
- Cast members must be respectful and supportive of their fellow cast members
- Cast members must remain in the room in which they are rehearsing unless granted permission to leave by a director or chaperone
- Cast members must be quiet and well-behaved while attending rehearsals
- Cast members may NOT use their cell phones while they are actively learning
- Photos and videos of rehearsals and fellow cast members without permission is strictly prohibited. Phones will be confiscated until the end of rehearsal if these policies are broken
- Cast members must strictly adhere to the Drama Dept. ZERO-TOLERANCE policy regarding teasing and bullying of fellow cast/crew members

The Drama Program is a cooperative program, and we do not charge a participation fee. For this reason, every drama family is expected to participate in the following:

- Mandatory volunteerism: drama families are required to volunteer in some capacity. There are jobs of all sizes, and even some you can do from home. This is a requirement. Failure to sign up for a job by the due date will result in dismissal of your cast member.
- Ad/Patron Drive: drama families are required to take part in this, our biggest fundraiser. Patron ads begin at \$5. Anyone for whom this is a financial hardship should speak to Mia Reich.
