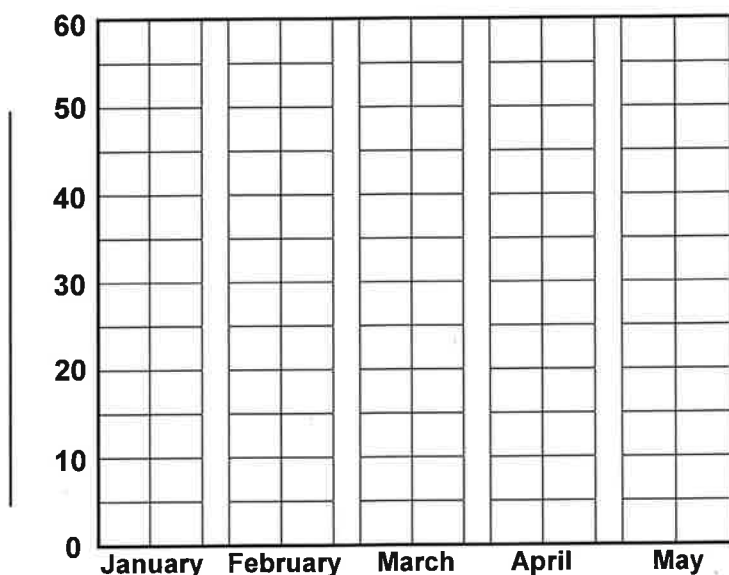


Newspapers double bar graph
