Uniform Updates: As I mentioned at Back to School Night, I do appreciate everyone's understanding as we try to tighten up the school uniform policy. I believe that if we are able to instill discipline and respect in small matters such as uniforms, the discipline and respect in larger issues will come naturally. I want to clarify the following:

- Uniform sneakers should be solid black or solid white.
- Students are not permitted to wear hoodies with their uniforms. The one exception to
 this rule is <u>this full-zip hooded sweatshirt that is sold in the spirit shop</u>. This hoodie
 is permitted with *gym uniforms only*.
- The uniform sweaters purchased from Risse brothers may be worn with the regular
 uniforms. These sweaters are permitted to be taken on and off throughout the day if the
 student is too warm or too cold. In addition to these sweaters, this full zip fleece from
 the spirit shop is permitted to be worn in the classrooms.

Outdoor Basketball Nets: Thank you to the Athletic Committee for managing the installment of new basketball nets on our blacktop with additional funds raised by their committee! We are very thankful for these nets and I want to remind everyone to treat them appropriately and with respect and care. If you see anybody mistreating these nets, please let the main office know immediately.
