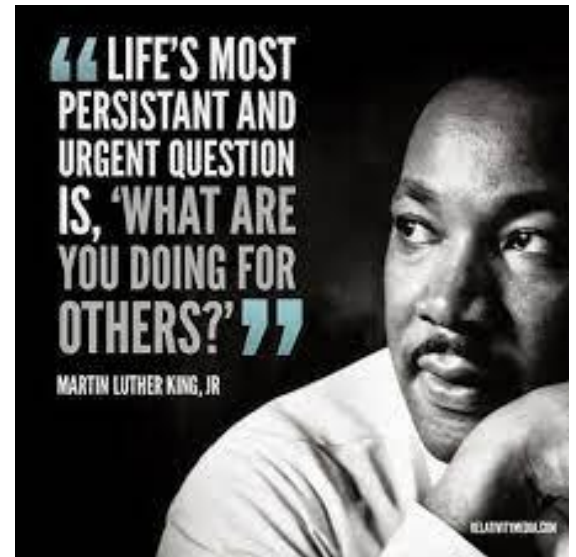

Please see below for important dates. **Please also note that there will be no \$40 enrollment fee to pay through FACTS this year.**

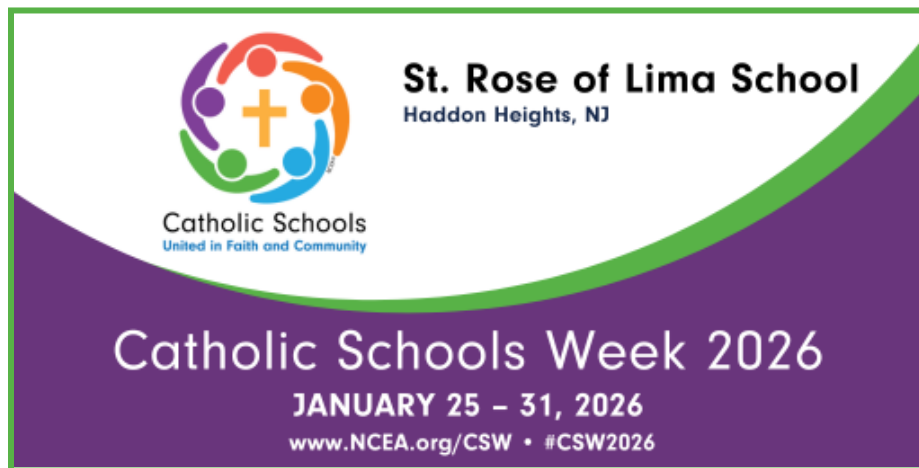
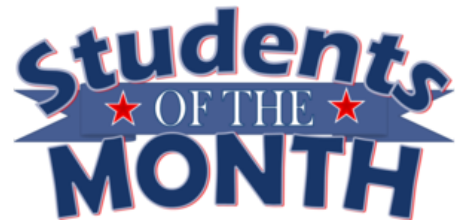

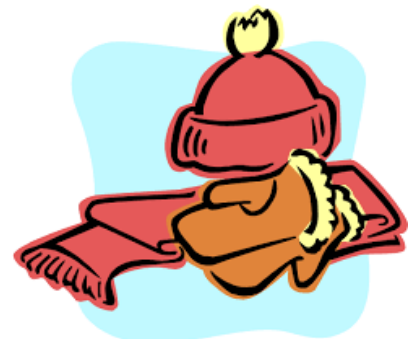
Catholic Schools Week: January 25 - January 31
