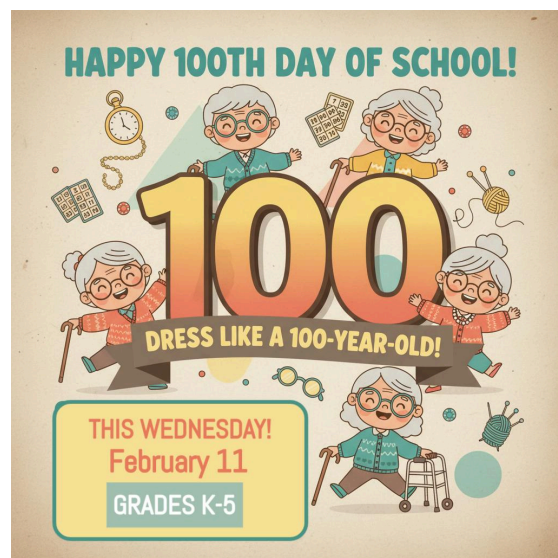

- **Scoliosis Screening**

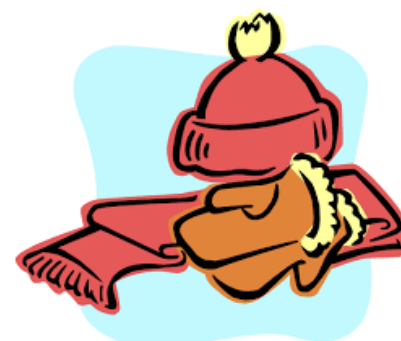
